## **Lesson 154 Notes (Simplified / Traditional):**

1. Notice a new usage of guò : Guò wán chūntiān and xiàtiān guò wán

guò : Guò wán chūntiān 过: 过完春天 / 過: 過完春天 When spring finishes xiàtiān guò wán 夏天过完 / 夏天過完 When summer finishes

2. New usage of xiàng : Xiàng wǒ jiù bǐjiào xǐhuān rè de tiānqì .

xiàng 像/像 like/to resemble

Xiàng wǒ jiù bǐjiào xǐhuān rè de tiāngì

像我就比较喜欢热的天气.../像我就比較喜歡熱的天氣..

Like me for example, I prefer hot weather

**3.** The verb lái is very versatile and extends in meaning as shown in examples such as jiē xià lái , ná chū lái , ràng wŏmen lái xíngróng qiūtiān de tiānqì and tōngcháng wŏmen dōu shì yòng "wēn de" shuǐ lái xĭzăo .

The verb to come is very versatile and extends in meaning as shown in examples such as next, to take out, let's describe autumn weather and normally we use warm water to take a bath.

**4.** Notice new ways to compare: Méiyǒu dōngtiān nàme lěng and méiyǒu xiàng xiàtiān nàme rè or dōngtiān gēn xiàtiān de tiāngì yǒu hěn dà de bù yíyàng.

Méiyŏu dōngtiān nàme lěng

没有冬天那么冷/没有冬天那麽冷

not as cold as winter

méiyŏu xiàng xiàtiān nàme rè

没有像夏天那么热/没有像夏天那麼熱

not as hot as summer

dōngtiān gēn xiàtiān de tiānqì yǒu hěn dà de bù yíyàng

冬天跟夏天的天气有很大的不一样 / 冬天跟夏天的天氣有很大的不一樣

winter and summer have very different weather.
