Raphael: Let's first listen to today's dialogue at normal speed .

Yann: I'm currently preparing to go traveling to America . So I have to spend a lot of time , finishing many things .

Cindy: Like what for example ?

Cindy: Feels like you will spend a lot of money .

Kirin: I'm currently preparing to go traveling to America .

Raphael: Do you remember what “zhèngzài” (to be in the midst of doing) means ?

Adam: That means “to be in the middle of doing something.”

Raphael: And what does “zhǔnbèi” (to get ready) mean ?

Adam: That means “to get ready.”

Raphael: And what does “lǚyóu” (travel) mean ?

Adam: That means “to go traveling.”

Raphael: So what does this sentence means ?

Kirin: I'm currently preparing to go traveling to America .

Adam: "I'm preparing for my trip to America."

Raphael: He then continues

Kirin: So I have to spend a lot of time , finishing many things .

Raphael: Do you remember what "bìxū" (to have to) means ?

Adam: That means "to have to."

Raphael: And what does "huā hěnduō shíjiān" (to spend a lot of time) ?

Adam: That means "to spend a lot of time."

Raphael: What does "Bǎ hěnduō shìqíng xiān zuò wán" (first finish doing many things) mean ?

Adam: That means "first finish doing many things."

Kirin: So I have to spend a lot of time , finishing many things .

Adam: "So I have to spend a lot of time doing many things."

Raphael: The young lady then asks

Kirin: Like what for example ?

Adam: "For example?"

Raphael: The young man then replies

Kirin: I have to first go to the bank to change money into American dollars .

Raphael: What does "Yínháng" (bank) mean ?

Adam: That means "bank."

Raphael: And what does "huàn měijīn" (change to American dollars) ?

Adam: That means "change to American dollars."

Kirin: I have to first go to the bank to change money into American dollars ,

Adam: “I first have to go to the bank and change money into American dollars.”

Raphael: He then continues

Kirin: then go to the travel agent to pay for my plane ticket .

Adam: In the previous sentence, he said “he first has to go to the bank.” In this sentence he continues with then , meaning “then” he has to

Kirin: then go to the travel agent to pay for my plane ticket .

Raphael: In this sentence we have today’s first new word .

Kirin: Travel agent .

Adam: By itself

Kirin: Travel

Adam: means “to travel”, and together

Kirin: Travel agent

Adam: means “travel agency.”

Kirin: then go to the travel agent to pay for my plane ticket .

Raphael: Do you remember what “fēijī” (airplane) means ?

Adam: That means “airplane.”

Raphael: And what does “piào” (ticket) mean ?

Adam: That means “ticket.”

Raphael: So what do you think “fù wǒde fēijī piào qián” (to pay for my airplane ticket) means ?

Adam: That means “to pay for my plane ticket.”

Kirin: then go to the travel agent to pay for my plane ticket .

Adam: “Then go to the travel agency and pay for my plane ticket.”

Raphael: The young woman then says

Kirin: Feels like you will spend a lot of money .

Raphael: What does “hǎo xiàng” (feeling) mean ?

Adam: That means “to seem like.”

Kirin: Feels like you will spend a lot of money .

Adam: “Feels like you will spend a lot of money.”

Raphael: The young man then says

Kirin: Right .

Adam: “That’s right.”

Kirin: I have to borrow money from my Dad .

Raphael: What do you think this sentence means ?

Kirin: I have to borrow money from my Dad .

Adam: “I have to borrow money from my father.”

Raphael: He then continues

Kirin: Because the money I’m making now is still not enough .

Raphael: What does “Bú gòu” (not enough) mean ?

Adam: That means “not enough.”

Kirin: Because the money I’m making now is still not enough .

Raphael: The young lady then replies

Raphael: What does “Zhù nǐ” (wish you) mean ?

Adam: That means “wish you.”

Raphael: And what does “kuàilè” (happy) mean ?

Adam: That means “happy.”

Raphael: So what do you think this sentence means ?

Kirin: Ok, hope you have a good time .

Adam: The literal meaning is “Ok, first wish you play happy”, which translates to “Ok, hope you have a good time.”

Kirin: Ok, hope you have a good time .
