206 Notes (Simplified / Traditional)

1. **Xiāngxià** refers to the countryside. Cities in Asia can be very crowded, so on weekends it is common for people to go to the countryside to get away from the hustle and bustle of the city.

Xiāngxià 乡 / 鄉下 Countryside

2. **Yúnhǎi** can be seen from high altitudes, when the weather conditions are right. Clouds form a layer below you, giving the impression of a white sea.

Yúnhǎi 云海 / 雲海 Sea of clouds

3. **Wēnquán** are common in Taiwan and Japan, and are another relaxing way for people to enjoy their weekends and times off.

Wēnquán 温泉 / 溫泉 Hot springs

Xǐ wēnquán literally means “to wash” or “bathe” in the hot springs. You may also hear **Pào wēnquán** meaning “to soak” in the hot springs.

Xǐ wēnquán 洗温泉 / 洗溫泉 Dip in the hot springs

Pào wēnquán 泡温泉 / 泡溫泉 Soak in the hot springs
