## **Lesson 236 Notes (Simplified / Traditional)**

**1.** As mentioned in the lesson, most Chinese festivals follow the lunar (Chinese traditional) calendar, while Western festivals follow the Western (solar) calendar. In addition to nónglì, other names for the traditional Chinese calendar include:

Xiàlì 夏历 / 夏曆 The lunar / traditional Chinese calendar

In addition to  $x\bar{1}$ , other names for the Western / solar calendar include:

Yánglì 阳历 / 陽曆 The solar / Western calendar

Gōnglì 公历 / 公曆 The solar / Western calendar

**2.** Duānwŭjié is a public holiday in both mainland China and in Taiwan. During this time, Sàilóngchuán are held in public rivers to celebrate the festival.

**3.** Zòngzi , commonly eaten during Duānwŭjié is a dumpling containing glutinous rice stuffed with other fillings and then wrapped in bamboo leaves.
