

Complete Lesson Transcript – Lesson 254 [English]

Kirin: Chinese Learn Online lesson 254 .

Hello everyone , I am Teacher Yang .

Raphael: Hello everyone , I am Teacher Lai .

Adam: And hello, I'm Adam.

Kirin: Welcome to our learning Chinese course .

Raphael: In today's lesson , we are going to teach you some new sentence patterns . Why are these sentence patterns so important ?

Kirin: Because when we speak Chinese , we often need to use these sentence patterns .

Raphael: Right, if you take all these sentence patterns and put them to memory , not only will you better understand the Chinese way of speaking , these sentence patterns will also let your Chinese sound more fluent . Ok, today's first sentence pattern is

Kirin: That's okay – this is enough .

Raphael: Actually, we have studied all the characters in this sentence pattern before . But when we listen to others speak , we often hear this sentence pattern . So for our students , this will be a great chance for review . Now in what kind of situation would we hear this sentence pattern ?

Kirin: For example when others want to help you , but you don't want to trouble them , in this type of situation , you can look for an easier way for them to choose .

Raphael: Please give us some examples to help us better understand how to use this sentence pattern .

Kirin: That's okay, I'll take these things by myself .

Raphael: So in what kind of situation would we hear this sentence ?

Kirin: Umm, when someone wants to get an item for me .

Raphael: Right . Now our next example is

Kirin: That's ok, I will take the train by myself .

Raphael: If someone wants to give you a ride to a place , but you don't want to bother him , you can say this sentence . Ok, the next sentence pattern has two new words

Kirin: Fortunately .

Adam: Fortunately.

Kirin: Otherwise .

Adam: Otherwise.

Raphael: Normally we take these two words and use them in the same sentence . For example

Kirin: Fortunately I took my cell phone when I went out , otherwise you wouldn't have found me .

Kirin: Fortunately it's not raining outside , otherwise we wouldn't be able to go to the seaside to swim .

Raphael: Ok, today's next new sentence pattern is

Kirin: Even .

Adam: Even.

Raphael: Please give us two examples .

Kirin: You are quite stupid , you don't even know how to write your own name .

Kirin: He is very scared of insects , he is even scared of ants .

Raphael: Today's final sentence pattern is

Kirin: Whatever / As long as .

Adam: Whatever or As long as.

Raphael: Please pay attention to the examples below and their English translations .

Kirin: Whatever you say , I can draw .

Adam: Whatever you say, I can draw.

Kirin: *As long as you exercise everyday and eat fewer snacks , you will definitely be successful in losing weight .*

Adam: As long as you exercise everyday and eat less snacks, you will be successful in losing weight.

Raphael: *Ok, let's take a moment to review the new sentence patterns that we taught you today .*

Adam: That's okay – this is enough.

Kirin: *That's okay – this is enough .*

Adam: Fortunately – otherwise.

Kirin: *Fortunately – otherwise .*

Adam: Even.

Kirin: *Even .*

Adam: Whatever or as long as.

Kirin: *Whatever / As long as .*
