Kirin: Meat .

Raphael: In the meat department , you can see many kinds of meats , like pork, beef, lamb, chicken etc .

Kirin: Fruits and vegetables .

Raphael: Fruits and vegetables means vegetables and fruits .

Kirin: Breads .

Raphael: If you would like to buy cookies or cakes , you can buy them at this department .

Kirin: Dairy products .

Raphael: In this section , you can find products related to milk or eggs .

Kirin: Daily necessities .

Raphael: Daily necessities are the same daily necessities that we studied before . In this section , you can buy the products that you use everyday . For example the products you use when you brush your teeth or wash your hair . Ok, let's now play a game .
