Raphael: [After they get engaged , what would they prepare to celebrate their getting married ?](#)

Kirin: [Wedding](#) .

Adam: Wedding.

Raphael: [When getting married , everyone hopes that their family and friends can come to their wedding , to celebrate it together with them . So what is the first thing we have to do ?](#)

Kirin: [To invite](#) .

Adam: To invite.

Raphael: We normally prepare a special invitation card to invite our family and friends . The next new word is .

Kirin: To participate / attend .

Adam: To participate or attend.

Raphael: When they receive the invitation card , they will come and attend the wedding . Now in the wedding , who are the most important two people ?

Kirin: Bride .

Adam: Literally, that's "new mother" or bride.

Kirin: Groom .

Adam: And that you may guess is the groom.

Raphael: When getting married , every country's traditions are a little bit different . Some weddings are quite simple , some are quite special , some will invite a lot of people to attend the wedding etc . For most bride and groom, after they get married , where do they go ?

Kirin: Honeymoon .

Adam: Literally, that's "honey" and "moon." Honeymoon.

Raphael: After the wedding finishes , the bride and groom are quite tired . So they use this period of time to rest and appreciate their new life . Today's final new word is
