Lesson 295 Notes (Simplified / Traditional):

1. As mentioned in the lesson, déyì has a more positive meaning than jiāoào.

déyì 得意 proud

2. Note the usage of cāi de dào and cāi bú dào.

cāi de dào 精得到 / 猜得到 to guess

cāi bú dào 猜不到 / 猜不到 not be able to guess

a. Wǒ jiù bù xiāngxìn nǐ cāi de dào

我就不相信你猜得到/我就不相信你猜得到

I don't believe you can guess what it is

b. Kěshì wǒ juéde nǐ háishì cāi bú dào.

可是我觉得你还是猜不到/可是我覺得你還是猜不到.

But I think you still won't guess it .

3. These lessons on games are a great way to observe some more natural speech between the speakers, in this case, the playful banter that may occur when two people are competing against each other.
