

Complete Lesson Transcript – Lesson 374 [English]

Kirin: Chinese Learn Online lesson 374 .

Hello everyone , I am Teacher Yang .

Raphael: Hello everyone , I am Teacher Lai .

Adam: And hello, I am Adam.

Kirin: Welcome to our learning Chinese course .

Raphael: Now please listen to the first word and question .

Kirin: To enroll .

Raphael: If you're a boss , and you're applying for a new employee , what kind of employee would you not be willing to hire ?

Kirin: If I was a boss , I would not be willing to hire a non-hardworking person to become my employee . Because this would not only waste my time it would also waste my money , I would hope that my employee would like his job , and be serious about his job .

Raphael: If the new employee that you hired , really likes his work , but he is not professional enough , what would you do ?

Kirin: I think I would first let him try out the job , and use a little time to train him , so that he can get more experience .

Raphael: Next, please listen to the second word and question .

Kirin: End of the month .

Raphael: No matter whether you're in Taiwan or overseas , every year, at the end of December, there are celebratory activities , why is that ?

Kirin: Because in many countries , at the end of December, people celebrate Christmas . They then prepare to celebrate the start of the new year , so it will be bustling everywhere , everyone is also in an excited mood .

Raphael: Like when I was young, I would really look forward to each year's Chinese new year (Spring Festival) , since I could get red envelopes from many adults .

Kirin: That's right . When you receive a red envelope , you're really very happy .

Raphael: Please continue to listen to the third word and question .

Kirin: Friendly .

Raphael: What kind of work most requires a friendly attitude ?

Kirin: Actually every job requires a friendly attitude . But especially for jobs that require you to serve other people . Sometimes a friendly attitude is more important than an academic degree .

Raphael: That's right . Because only this way will customers feel that they are respected , as well next time they will definitely ask you to continue serving them .

Kirin: I feel the same way too . Service attendants who are especially friendly , can not only make customers happy , they can improve the store's business .

Raphael: Next, please listen to the fourth word and question .

Kirin: Guest .

Raphael: If you are the boss of a restaurant , what can you do attract more customers to your restaurant to eat your things or buy your products ?

Kirin: If I was the boss , I would definitely hire a cook with a lot of experience , who would prepare fresh, delicious food everyday , decorate the restaurant well , and organize different activities every month to attract more customers .

Raphael: As well, I think customer suggestions are very important . So I would take some forms and ask customers who come to the restaurant to fill them out , to let them write down their suggestions , this way I would know what other places there are that could be better .

Kirin: You're really great ! I believe you would definitely be a very good boss !

Raphael: Thank you for your compliment . Finally, please listen to the fifth word and question .

Kirin: To start out .

Raphael: If you're traveling overseas , before you set off , what things would you have to prepare ? And what things would you pay attention to ?

Kirin: When you travel abroad , before you set off you should check and see if your passport , plane ticket and luggage are all prepared properly . As well, you should also prepare some money or a credit card . Important things should be carried on your body , so that they won't be stolen by a thief or get lost .

Raphael: You're completely correct . If you lose important things when you're traveling , that would be pretty bad .

Kirin: So no matter whether it's before you set off , or when you reach another country , you have to pay attention to whether the important things on your body are still there or not .
