## Lesson 379 Notes :

1. Some of the elements emphasized in Chinese, are different from in English. For example, in the sentence [Nà jiā cāntīng de cài hěn fēngfù](#) , the literal meaning is “That restaurant’s food is very plentiful”. The word [fēngfù](#) is often used with food to describe abundance, such as going to someone’s house for dinner and seeing how much food has been prepared for the occasion.

2. Similarly, in the sentence [Tāmen mài de dōngxi pǐnzhì dōu hěn shízài](#) , we don’t normally use the word “authentic” or “real” to describe quality, whereas it is used in Chinese.

The quality of things they sell are all very authentic
